Higher Heights



Adult Program

Higher Heights helps adults to:

Establish 90-day goals and resources to guide them towards accomplishing their goals. Objectives include and are measured by a client's participation in weekly, confidential meetings with Client Coordinators, goal achievements, attendance in MIGHT CDRC classes, and continual follow-up.

Classes offered include:

Career Readiness (6 hours)

This Adult/Teen class uses tools and assessments to determine areas of interest for clients in order to link them to employment they may enjoy. In addition, this class teaches application, interview, resume and soft skills.

Money Management (4 hours)

This class is a required study that teaches Adult/Teen clients how to manage a current budget of any income, banking, saving, and credit information to become financially knowledgeable and more prepared for financial stability.

Parenting Classes (6-10 hours)

These classes are designed to help parents build on existing parenting skills to develop close relationships with their children. Parents receive support, handouts and available community resources.

Classes offered (cont.)

Anger Management (6-12 hours)

Anger Management is a course to address and overcome anger by providing anger management, conflict resolution, and problem solving skills.

Domestic Violence (10-12 hours)

This is a course that addresses the individual in their pursuit for peace and stability. Individuals look at self-improvement in relation to personal conduct, growth and awareness, as well as a new perspective in spite of external factors.

Insurance

In this course the participants will gain knowledge in the areas of insurance that include: Renters, Auto, and Life. In addition, the liabilities involved when participants do NOT have these coverages are explained.
